In Incoming server information, select Server Type as POP or IMAP.

<u>Step 8</u>

In the Server address field enter mail.yourdomain.com (If your domain name is testdomain.net, then you would put mail.testdomain.net).

<u>Step 9</u>

If you are configuring Server type as POP, Port should be 110. If you are configuring Server type as IMAP, Port should be 143.

Port should be 25 or 25 or 587.

<u>Step 14</u>

Tick Requires Authentication checkbox.

Click Next button and the Finish button.
